



5 Different Actions (min. conditions)

Postdoctoral Fellowships

- Individual application with a supervisor and host institution for post-doctoral research
- Max. 8 years research experience after PhD (new rule)
- Research opportunity in Europe and in the world
- Career development opportunity with mobility rule
- Resubmission is not possible if stayed under threshold (70 over 100)

Doctoral Networks

- At least 3 different partners from 3 different countries
- At least 1 EU MS/AC participation in the consortium
- Recruitment of PhD Fellows with EU funding
- Creation of Standart / Joint / Industry Doctorate Programmes
- Resubmission is not possible if stayed under 80 over 100 as score

Staff Exchange

- At least 3 different partners from 3 different countries

Postdoctoral Fellowships (PF): Objectives

- Foster excellence through the implementation of a research project;
- Enhance the creative and innovative potential of researchers holding a PhD (training on transferable skills & career development);
- Focus on i3 (international, inter-sectoral, interdisciplinary) mobility;
- Bridges with and exposure to the non-academic sector.

All scientific fields (including Euratom-related areas)



Postdoctoral Fellowships (PF): Types of Action

PF is a mono-beneficiary action to support post-doctoral research and careers and has the following options:

- <u>European Postdoctoral Fellowships</u> coming to Europe from any country in the world or moving within Europe;
- ✓ Global Postdoctoral Fellowships outside EU Member States and Horizon Europe AC.




Postdoctoral Fellowships (PF): Participation

Participating organisations*

Legal entity in an EU Member State or HE Associated country

Researchers:

- in possession of PhD at the call deadline (successful defense before call deadline);
- up to 8 years research experience after PhD (exceptions: career breaks, work outside research, research outside Europe for reintegrating researchers,...)
- Nationality:
 - EFs: any nationality
 - GFs: nationals or long-term residents of MS or HE AC *;
- Mobility rule: not resided/had main activity in the country of
 - EFs the beneficiary
 - GFs host organisation for more than 12 months in the 36 months before call deadline







Postdoctoral Fellowships (PF): Conditions

Duration

EFs: 12-24 months;

GFs: 24-36 months (12-24 outgoing phase + 12 months mandatory return)

Secondments (non compulsory) Worldwide

- EFs: not more than 1/3 of total of project
- GFs not more than 1/3 of total of outgoing phase + a max 3 months at beginning of the project at the beneficiary (to be deducted from the outgoing phase)
 Note: encoded in Part A (Call specific questions)

Non academic placement (NAP) (non compulsory) EU MS or HE AC

Additional period of max 6 months after project completion
 Note: encoded in part A as participant organisation + letter of commitment

MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships → ERA Fellowships



ERA Fellowships (widening activities)

- No separate application or evaluation integral part of the MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships call
 application form;
- For specific countries* available in Work Programme;
- Must be submitted by a host institution from a 'Widening' country;
- Only for EFs, GFs don't qualify;
- Only proposals scoring over 70% in the PF call will be considered and failed to reach an adequate place in the ranking to be funded under that call;
- Timing aligned with PF call.

NOTE: "call specific question" to be completed in the PF submission for EF to indicate willingness to participate in this call (only if host organisation is a qualifying country)



What are Doctoral Networks?

Multi-beneficiaries Actions to set up **doctoral programmes** comprising:

- ➤ Doctoral Networks (standard): Training in academia and/or industry
- ➤ Industrial Doctorates: Training in academia and industry, Joint supervision
- ➤ Joint Doctorates: Joint collaborations leading to a joint/double/multiple doctoral degree, Joint selection and supervision; pre-agreement for joint degrees required





Doctoral Networks – 2023 Features

Size: Up to 540 person-months for all implementation modes **Duration:**

- Programme: max. 48 months for Standard DN and DN-ID; max 60 months for DN-JD
- Fellowship: between 3 and 36 months for Standard DN and DN-ID; max 48 months for DN-JD
- > Secondments: worldwide, up to 1/3 of the fellowship duration for Standard DN; no limitation for DN-ID and DN-JD
- Industrial doctorates (DN ID):
 - > At least 50% in the non-academic sector (can be in the same country as the academic host organisation); non-academic sector as beneficiary or AP
 - Academic and non-academic organisations jointly supervise
- Joint doctorates (DN JD):
 - Enrolment in a joint/double or multiple PhD (delivered by entities located in at least 2 MS/AC)
 - Joint admission, selection, training, supervision, governance
 - Letters of pre-agreement to deliver joint/double/multi degrees (template)







Doctoral Networks – Eligibility Conditions

- At least 3 independent legal entities:
 - Each established in a different EU Member States or Horizon Europe Associated Country
 - Minimum of 1 beneficiary from an EU Member State
- All beneficiaries must recruit at least one doctoral candidate. They are required
 to host at their premises and supervise recruited researchers, or use associated
 partners linked to them to do so
- Not more than 40.0% of the EU contribution may be allocated to beneficiaries in the same country or to a single international organisation.
- Specific eligibility conditions for Industrial and Joint Doctorates
- ! Re-submission restrictions for proposals scoring below 80% in Call 2022







Doctoral Networks – Eligible Participants

- Who can apply?
 - Any Legal Entity from anywhere in the world
 - But not all applicants are automatically eligible for funding
- Consortia of:
 - Universities, research institutions and research infrastructures
 - Businesses including SMEs
 - Other socio-economic actors
- No minimum / maximum number of Associated Partners





Doctoral Networks – Academic / non-academic sectors

Academic sector

- public or private higher education establishments
- public or private nonprofit research organisations
- ✓ International European Research Organisations



Non-academic sector

✓ any socioeconomic actor not included in the academic sector





Doctoral Networks - Eligible Countries

EU Member State (MS): 27 countries/ overseas territories

Associated Country(AC): Albania, Armenia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Faroe Islands, Georgia, Iceland, Israel, Kosovo, Moldova, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Norway, Serbia, Tunisia, Turkey, Ukraine

* Morocco, United Kingdom

Note: Switzerland is **not** an associated country

Doctoral Networks – Eligible Researchers

- Researchers must be doctoral candidates (not already in possession of a doctoral degree at the date of recruitment)
- Be recruited following an open, merit-based and transparent recruitment
- Researchers must be enrolled in a doctoral programme, in at least 1 EU Member State/Associated Country (at least 2 for Joint Doctorates)
- Any nationality
- Mobility rule: must not have resided or carried out main activity in the country of the recruiting beneficiary for more than 12 months in the 36 months immediately before their recruitment date.

RESEARCH FIELD: Hydrogen storage technologies, embedding geology, microbiology, geochemistry, geophysics, fluid dynamics and geomechanics monitoring.

The overarching objective of this European Doctoral Network "Safe underground Hydrogen storage IN Earth subsurface reservoirs" (acronym: SHINE) is to investigate the hydrogen/rock/pore fluid processes with the aim of assessing the feasibility of underground hydrogen storage technologies within subsurface porous reservoirs, through 10 cutting edge research and training projects at doctoral level.

The 10 PhD projects on offer are interlinked and focused on the characterization of the reservoir and caprock properties including modelling their mechanical integrity, geochemical stability and multi-phase flow properties during hydrogen storage operations. The training will involve both industrial and academic sector partners with the aim of creating a new generation of scientists able to develop technologies, propose new solutions to sub-surface



MSCA COFUND

Mono-beneficiary action to **co-fund** new or existing national, regional, internationa schemes for **doctoral** training and **postdoctoral** fellowships.

Focus

- Spread best practices of the MSCA by promoting high standards in the recruitment process and excellent working conditions
- Introduce sustainable structuring effects, by promoting excellent and sustainable research training, international, intersectoral and interdisciplinary cooperation and mobility
- Encourage synergies with Cohesion policy funds as well as the Recovery and Resilience Facility. Programmes could focus on specific disciplines, notably when based on Smart Specialisation Strategies.





MSCA COFUND

Modalities:

- **Doctoral Programmes:** offer research training activities to allow doctoral candidates to develop and broaden their skills and competences. They will lead to the award of a doctoral degree in at least one EU Member State or Horizon Europe Associated Country. The training activities should be based on the EU Principles on Innovative Doctoral Training.
- Postdoctoral Programmes: fund individual advanced research training and career development fellowships for postdoctoral researchers. The programmes should offer training to develop key transferable skills and competences common to all fields, foster innovation and entrepreneurship and promote and (where appropriate) reward Open Science practices.
