





- To engage in the discussion with other groups of MCAA on policy making.





-Increasing the visibility of the MCAA Turkey Chapter on a local and global scale and attract researchers to Turkey through MCSA;


-Raise awareness about EU-funding opportunities for both early-stage and middle stage researchers;
